The CHRIST CANDLE: THE LIGHT OF GOD...

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and God said (Genesis 1:3), "Let there be Light!"

John 1:1-5 "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. Through Him all things were made; without Him nothing was made that has been made. In Him was life, and that life was the Light of men. The Light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not overcome it."

God separated Light (GOOD) from darkness (EVIL).

The first humans (Adam & Eve) were created GOOD, but chose to disobey God [SIN], bringing consequences to all mankind, separating us from God.

God's remedy for this broken relationship was to send His own Son as the payment and the cure for sin's curse. Jesus said (John 8:12), "I am the Light of the world. Whoever follows Me will never walk in darkness, but will have the Light of life."
