1.19.20 ~ Ephesians 6:1-9, God-Ordained Relationships: Part Three

See Deuteronomy 6:4-9... The parents of Israel failed, just as many parents today fail. Why?

Read Ephesians 6:1-4... Most parents don't train their children to obey and honor them, let alone God. See Deuteronomy 5:16

OT consequences for disobedient children: See Exodus 21:15...

See Deuteronomy 21:18-21...

Children do not know God naturally, His love must be shown, His plan told. to them.

In two studies [one secular, one Christian] similar factors were found to be beneficial to the parent-child relations:

1. Parents expressing love for each person.
2. Firm, fair, consistent discipline & expectations
3. Father as head of the home.

Proverbs 1:8, "Hear, my son, your father's instruction And do not forsake your mother's teaching."

Proverbs 13:24, "He who withholds his rod hates his son, But he who loves him disciplines him diligently."

Proverbs 19:18, "Discipline your son while there is hope, And do not desire his death."

Proverbs 22:6, "Train up a child in the way he should go, Even when he is old he will not depart from it." 15, "Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; The rod of discipline will remove it far from him."

Proverbs 23:13-14, "Do not hold back discipline from the child, although you strike him with the rod, he will not die. You shall strike him with the rod and rescue his soul from Sheol."

Proverbs 29:15, The rod and reproof give wisdom, But a child who gets his own way brings shame to his mother." 17, "Correct your son, and he will give you comfort; He will also delight your soul."

Children are blessings from God.

Matthew 19:14, Jesus said, ""Let the children alone, and do not hinder them from coming to Me; for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."

Read Ephesians 6:5-8... Slaves are to serve their masters, as if serving the Lord Himself.

Read Ephesians 6:9... Masters are to take care of their slaves, for we all serve one Master, who is in heaven.

Galatians 3:26-28, "For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus."

1John 3:1a, "See how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, that we would be called children of God; and such we are."

1John 5:1-2, "Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and whoever loves the Father loves the child born of Him. By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and observe His commandments."

Husbands are to be the head of the home, by loving and caring for their wives.

Parents are not to provoke their children, but to love, nurture, and train them.

Masters are to care for and provide what is right and fair to their servants, just as they are servants of God, who cares for them.

Ephesians 4:32, "Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you."

Colossians 3:17, "Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father." **23-25**, "Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance. It is the Lord Christ whom you serve. For he who does wrong will receive the consequences of the wrong which he has done, and that without partiality."
