Part Two: Be Examples!

See 1Thessalonians 1:5... Paul & Co experienced God's power as they preached salvation in Thessalonica.

See **Romans 10:8-10, 13, 17...**

See **2Corinthians 4:4-6...**

John 3:19, "This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil."

See **Ephesians 5:6-16...**

Paul, Silas and Timothy's preaching wasn't just with words (**1Thessalonians 1:5**), but also in power, the Holy Spirit and with conviction. The Thessalonians experienced it (**1Thessalonians 2:13**), not as the word of men, but the Word of God with power in those who believe.

See 1Thessalonians 1:6... The believers became imitators of Paul and his companions, and of the Lord." Following Paul, who was trying to exemplify the Lord (see **1John 2:6; Hebrews 13:7; Philippians 4:8-9**).

The evidence of new birth, spiritual birth, is to imitate Christ, to be a Christian [an example of Christ] showing the newness of the Life that we have received from God (see **John 1:12-13; 3:6-8**).

See 1Thessalonians 1:7-8...

See **1Corinthians 6:19-20...**

2Corinthians 13:5, "Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith; examine yourselves! Or do you not recognize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you—unless indeed you fail the test?"

The behavior of the believers in Thessalonica was God-honoring and Christ-exalting, the Gospel of Christ was continually going out from them, not only in Macedonia and Achaia but everywhere.

See 1Thessalonians 1:9... The Thessalonians served the living God, by the way they lived.

Romans 12:1, "Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship."

When you repent of sin and believe in Christ as Savior and Lord, it causes a total change (**2Corinthians 5:17**), in who you serve, obey, honor, and worship.

See 1Thessalonians 1:10... True Christianity is exemplified by our work of faith, labor of love, and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ."

Christians expectantly wait for Christ to return, for He is the Creator, Sustainer, Lord, Savior, and Judge over all.

Titus 2:11-14, "For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men, instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus, who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds."

1Peter 2:9-10, "You are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; for you once were not a people, but now you are the people of God; you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy."

2Peter 3:11-12, "what sort of people ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God..." **18**, "...grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him *be* the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen."
