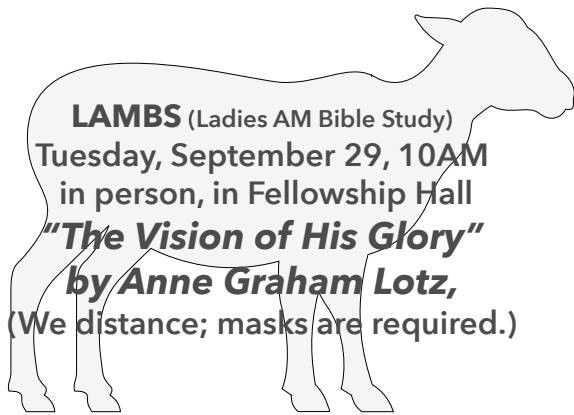
Holy words long preserved for our walk in this world,

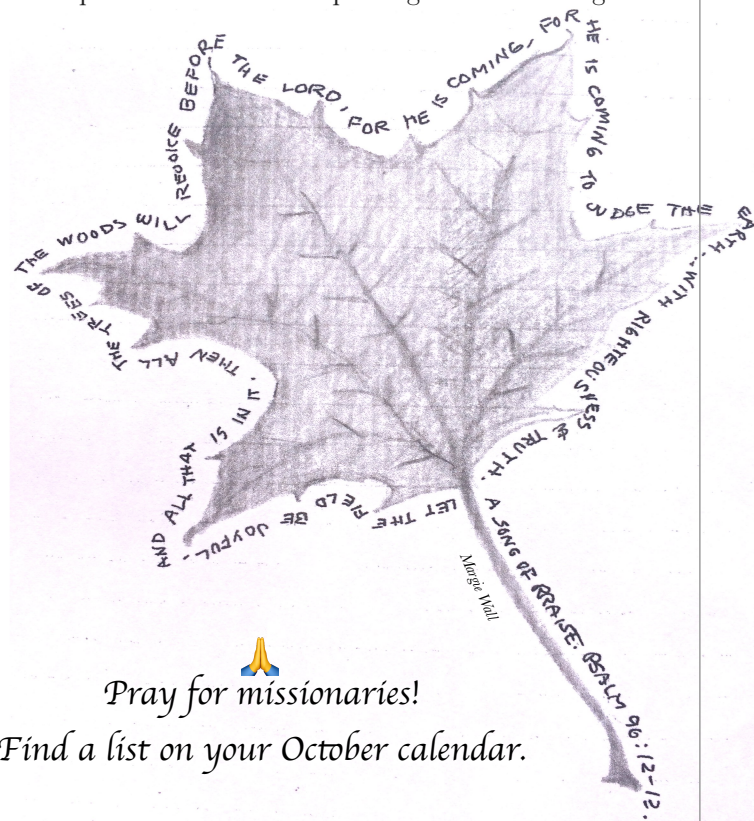
🌟 **Packing OCC Shoeboxes, Date to be Determined—in November**
