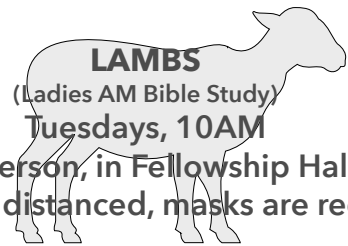

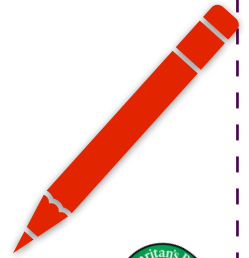
Shopping List for Shoeboxes:
