All Your purposes, for Your glory.

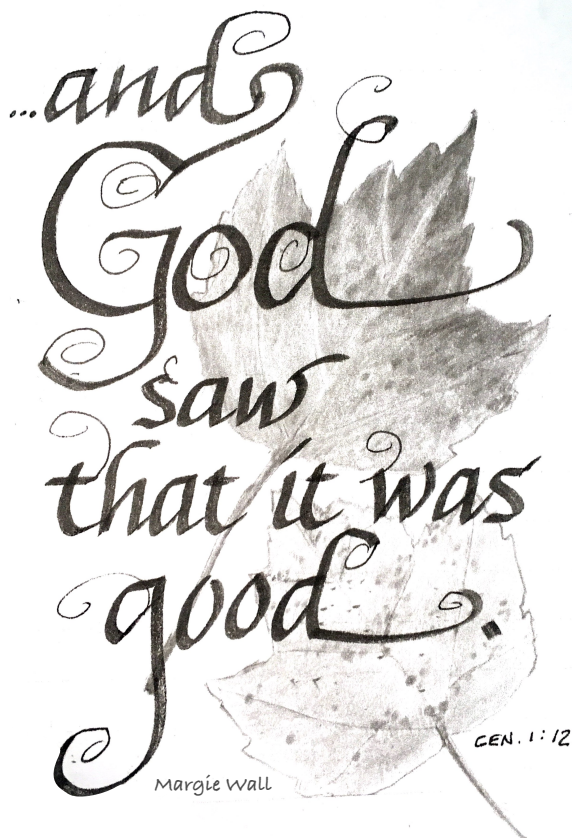
Teach us Lord full obedience,

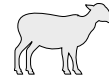
Last week's offering was: Weeks: \$2080 October's total was: \$9709
