We gather together to ask the Lord's blessing; He chastens and hastens His will to make known; The wicked oppressing now cease from distressing. Sing praises to His name; He forgets not his own.

Beside us to guide us, our God with us joining, Ordaining, maintaining His kingdom divine; So from the beginning the fight we were winning; Thou, Lord, was at our side; the glory be Thine!

#### **Come Ye Thankful People Come**

1 Come, ye thankful people, come, Raise the song of harvest home; All is safely gathered in, Ere the winter storms begin. God our Maker doth provide For our wants to be supplied; Come to God's own temple, come, Raise the song of harvest home.

2 We ourselves are God's own field, Fruit unto His praise to God to yield; Wheat and tares together sown Unto joy or sorrow grown; First the blade and then the ear. Then the full corn shall appear; Lord of harvest, grant that we Wholesome grain and pure may be.

3 For the Lord our God shall come. And shall take His harvest home; From His field shall purge away All that does offend that day, Give His angels charge at last In the fire the tares to cast: But the fruitful ears to store In His storehouse evermore.

4 Even so, Lord, quickly come, Bring Your final harvest home; Gather thou Your people in, Free from sorrow, free from sin, There, forever purified, In Your presence to abide; Come, with all thine angels, come, Raise the glorious harvest home.

This hymn was written in rural England in the mid-nineteenth century, when the life of the village during the winter depended on the bounty of the autumn harvest. While the first stanza of this hymn rejoices over the harvest, the last three stanzas expound on the reminder this image gives of the Parable of the Wheat and the Weeds in Matthew 13. The hymn concludes with a prayer that the final harvest at His Second Coming would happen soon.
