Hymn notes:

- *O Come, O Come Emmanuel* was translated by JM Neale in 1851 from Latin to English. It was originally written in Latin in the 8th or 9th century, where it was sung antiphonally (responsively) in ancient church services.
 - What names of Christ do you see in this hymn?
 - Notice the plaintiff longing of the sinful for a Savior, set to a minor key.
 - Note, also, the bursts of rejoicing in the refrain, for the hope and fulfillment of His coming.

God's GIFT Foretold (see John 1:14, 18, 29-34; Hebrews 1:1-3)**


















The change and bills put in the little colorful drawstring bags goes to feed hungry people. Remember, 100% goes to FOOD!
