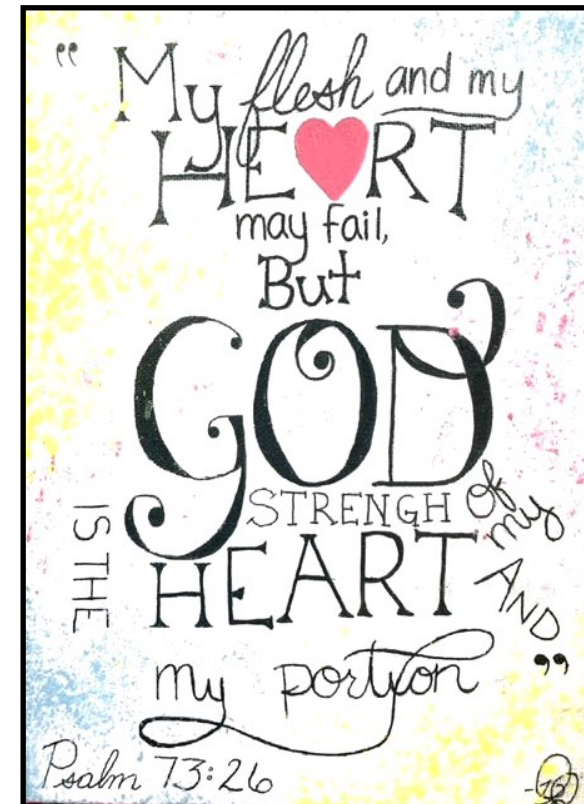
If you're inside worshipping, there are offering baskets as you exit.
