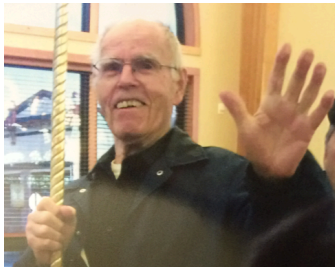


Penny Pick Up Challenge
