Current Information: This county is now in the “High” category as of Friday. This can change every two weeks according to the amount of cases and hospitalizations. Our Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall may now, again, contain 25% of their capacity (about 50, and 20, respectively.)

Fishing Derby: We are all wondering about Fishing Derby, which normally would have occurred Saturday, May 14, and can bring about 200 children and their families on this campus. Because the pandemic has not reached the point of herd immunity, and mandates are still in flux, this event has been canceled. (Please get vaccinated if possible.) The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife will stock Eckman Lake with those gorgeous trout, but will not net them, since the event cannot happen. They also said they would not supply the fishing poles, which made the event undoable as well. **NEXT YEAR we must continue on with this two decade tradition!**

Vacation Bible Adventure is still on our calendar for July 26-30—for now. Our sister church, Trinity Baptist in Renton, Washington is moving forward on their own VBA on a smaller scale. Director Susan Partch doesn't like having to cap their attendance, but will do what they must. Her words concerning our possibility:

We are prayerfully holding Waldport VBA loosely. Realizing it may not happen, could happen in an altered way, etc. We are good with waiting on the Lord and on your wisdom about what you decide to do. Our feelings won't be hurt. We will be here for you if it works out! We are talking about bringing a smaller team. Many want to come, but probably will need to limit it.

Please pray for wisdom and for lots of kids to be able to come safely. Pray about volunteering...we will have applications soon. Pray that leaders will continue to see how this can be possible and to move forward with God's grace!

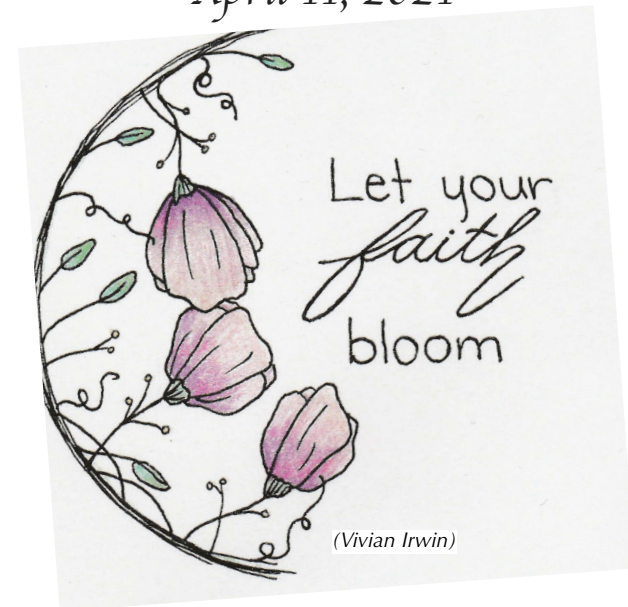
Offering plates are available inside and outside.
