(Where has God prepared for you to serve?)

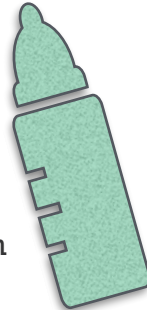
- **Treasurer:** This person helps our financial director, Norm K.

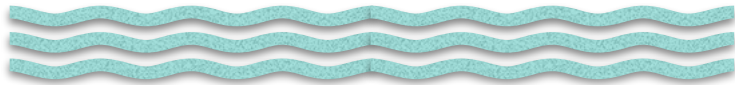
