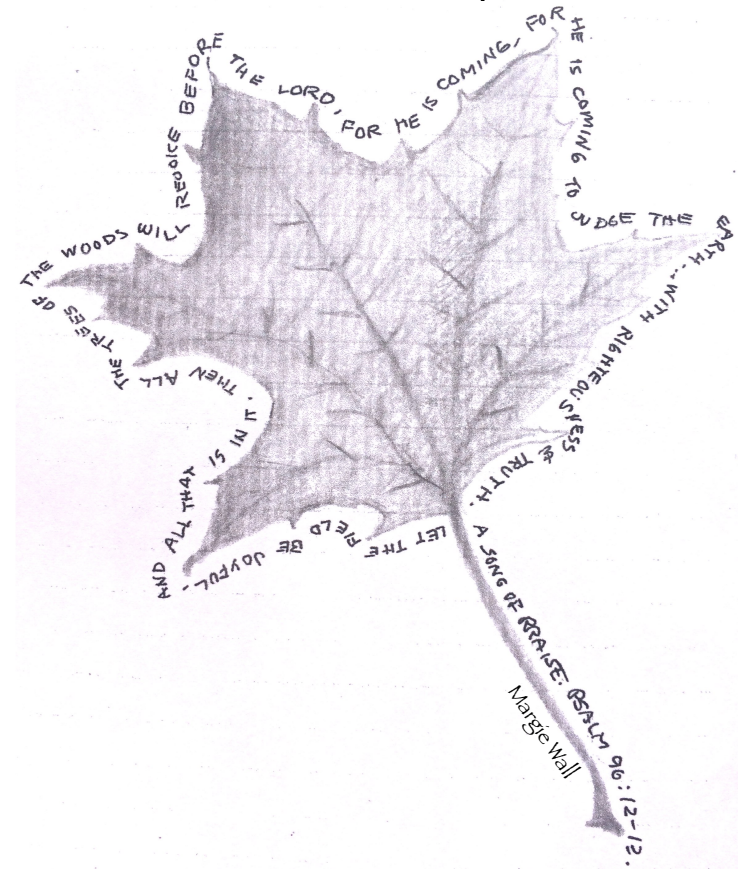
Offering plates are located in the back of the sanctuary, If your offering is designated for anything except General Fund, it should be noted in the MEMO area of the check.
