Candle of Prophecy: GOD'S GIFT FORETOLD

Throughout the ancient past, the Prophets of God foretold the coming of the Holy One, God's Own Son. He would be born to a virgin in Bethlehem, by God's Spirit, and He would be named Jesus [God's Salvation], and would be called Immanuel [God with us].

The Prophets wrote how this One to come, the Messiah, would be punished for all our sins, restoring peace between us and God, like it was in the beginning, before sin's curse came upon all of creation.

God's Son would put on human flesh, live among us, show us the Father, and die for our sins to provide salvation to all who repent and believe in Him (John 1:14), "And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth," (18), "No one has seen God at any time; the only begotten God who is in the bosom of the Father, He has explained Him," (29), "The next day he [John] saw Jesus coming to him and said, 'Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (34), "'This is the One who baptizes in the Holy Spirit.' I myself have seen, and have testified that this is the Son of God."
