5. Read Isaiah 6:3 and Leviticus 19:2. What attribute of God is communicated here? What does this attribute of God have to do with us? We fail in this area pretty consistently. What remedy has God made available to deal with this fact? There are some who say to sin all you want because forgiveness has been made available. What do you think about that? What does the Bible say about it in Romans 6:1-4? How now shall we live?

6. What personal needs has the Holy Spirit exposed during this study? How can we pray with you about those needs? Consider memorizing John 1:1.

1. Describe something you have seen that you thought was totally unique. What makes God totally unique? Read Psalm 115:3, Isaiah 55:11 and Jeremiah 32:17. Which of God's omni- attributes do these verses describe? How does this impact our lives? Is there anything God can not do?

2. Read Psalm 147:5, John 21:17, Hebrews 4:12-13, and 1 John 3:20. Which of God's omni-attributes do these verses describe? Is there anything God doesn't know? Does anything surprise God? What does God's knowledge have to do with his authority? How is God's knowledge a blessing to us?

3. Read Psalm 139:7-12. Which of God's omni-attributes do these verses describe? What does it mean for God to be everywhere? How does this apply to time? Why is this a blessing to us? What does Isaiah 7:14 have to do with God's presence?

4. Read Psalm 119:68, Psalm 145:9, and Matthew 19:16-17. We don't always list this as one of God's omni- attributes, but it certainly can be considered one.
